Scope of the Conference

A fter the success of the 1st and 2nd ECSM European Conference on Sewage Sludge we are organising the 3rd event in the series.

This conference aims to bring together researchers and engineers from universities, R&D laboratories, water agencies and private companies involved in the management of sewage sludge as well as governmental delegates.

As the environmental regulations became stricter, the production of sewage sludge increased continuously in the last decade.
