

Master's Degree in Spanish and Comparative Literature

Arts and Humanities

The study programme of the MA in Spanish and Comparative Literature contains a total of 60 credits, distributed in a course that includes all the theoretical and practical aspects which students should acquire: compulsory and optional subjects, the Final MA Project, and other complementary formative activities. Each of optional subjects have 3 credits ECTS.

In the study programme, which moves from a theoretical-practical perspectives to a more research-based approach, 39 optional credits are offered, and the student will have to take 33. In this sense, each student will make a detailed study with their tutor of the best itinerary for them, with the most convenient subjects to complete their training. Although the MA is studied on campus, the theoretical sessions are reduced to their minimum, in order to facilitate and strengthen the autoformative activities as well as the practical sessions and seminars, so the students can acquire the necessary competences.

Enrolment period

If any interested students receive the information after the official enrolment periods have closed, they should contact the Postgraduate Unit of the University of León, as there may be a slim possibility of enrolling in the course.

Enrolment prices

- There are two sorts of payment: total and deferred.
- The enrolment price in the MA in Spanish and Comparative Literature corresponds to Public Prices.
- The minimal number of enrolment credits per students in the first school year will be of 30 credits ECTS.
- According to the foreseen procedure to the adaptation of new degrees, the students who have taken the formative period and that have not still finished their studies in the old-style degree programmes, may request the recognition of the 33 optional credits, studying just the compulsory subject (12 credits) in the A module and the Final MA Project (15 credits).
