REPORT ON JOINT AND DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMS IN THE GLOBAL CONTEXT

INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

The Institute of International Education (IIE) and the Freie DNAL Universität Berlin, Germany, have released a report on Joint and Double Degree Programs in the Global Context: Report of an

International Survey. Based on a survey conducted in Spring 2011, it examines the responses from 245 higher education institutions in 28 different countries and presents major developments regarding joint and double degree programmes from a global perspective, as well as country-specific trends for the six countries with the highest number of institutions that have responded to the survey: Australia, France, Germany, Italy, United Kingdom the U.S.
